



Information for Potential Directors of the GV Sports Hall of Fame

History: The Greater Victoria Sports Hall of Fame (GVSHOF) is a not for profit organization constituted under the charities act of British Columbia in 1991. Ours is a “working” Board of sixteen members and we have no paid staff. The Board meets once a month and more often as is required.

Home: The GVSHOF’s home is in the Save-On Foods Memorial Centre where we have had our displays since the opening of the building.
